SUBJECT: Retirement Board Election

Recently you received an Election Notice advising you that Voter Registration and Elections would be conducting an election for one Retiree Member and one Alternate Retiree Member of the Retirement Board of the Sacramento County Employees' Retirement System (SCERS). As stated in the Election Notice, the last day for interested candidates to file nomination papers was September 14, 2007.

As of 5 p.m. on September 14, 2007, only one member, Ms. Nancy Wolford-Landers, who is the current Incumbent, submitted the required nomination papers for consideration as the Retiree Member of the SCERS Retirement Board.

California Government Code Section 31523 declares that if an election has been called and only one member has been nominated for the position, no election shall be held and a unanimous ballot shall be cast in favor of the nominated member. Accordingly, with Ms. Nancy Wolford-Landers as the only nominee, voting will not be necessary, and a ballot will not be sent to you for the Retiree Member as previously indicated.

Please note that there were multiple candidates for the Alternative Retiree Member. A ballot has been mailed to you, so that you may vote for the Alternate Retiree Member. The voting period begins October 22, 2007 and ends on November 2, 2007 at 5 p.m.
